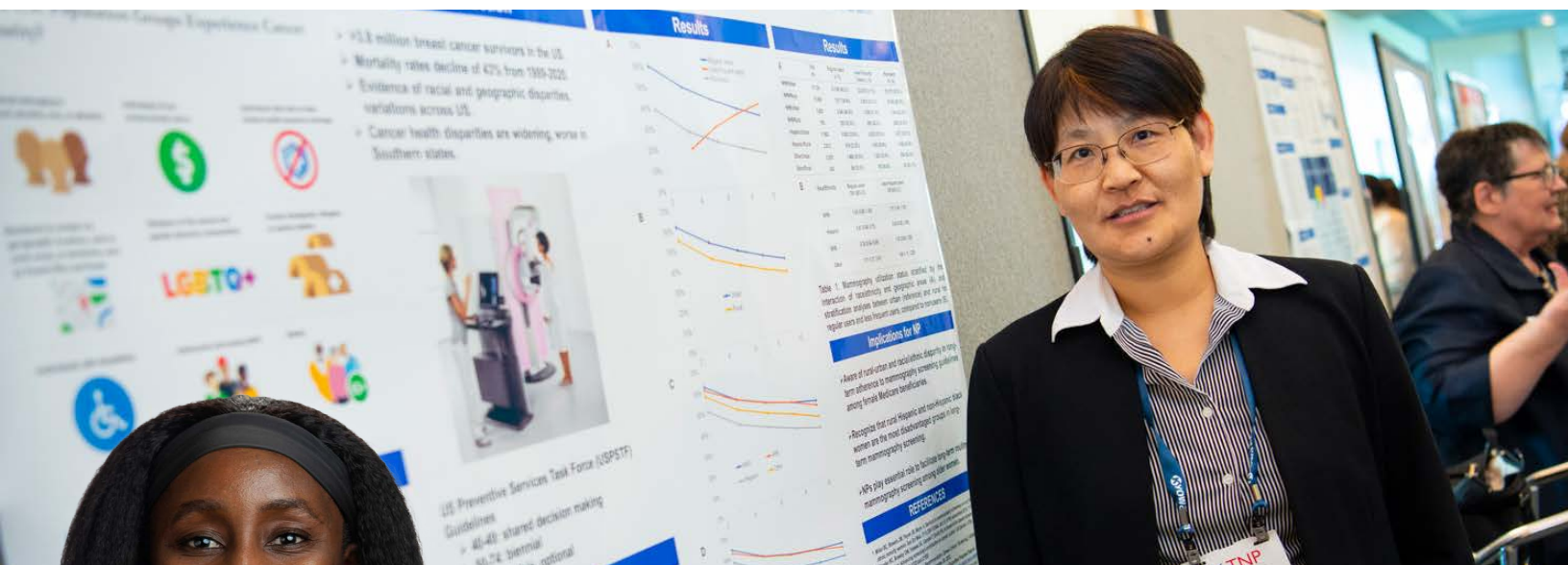

Program

TNP University Ambassador Program Requirements

A University Ambassador agrees to share information about TNP and encourage faculty and students to:

- Join and maintain TNP membership
- Attend TNP conferences and events
- Volunteer

Annual Fee

A university registers as a University Ambassador each year. The 2026 annual fee is \$1,200. Program benefits are based on a calendar year beginning on January 1, 2026, and ending on December 31, 2026.

Relationship Description

Participation in the program is voluntary. This program does not create a partnership, joint venture, parent/subsidiary relationship, or other similar association between the parties. The University understands that it will not represent that such a relationship between the parties has been or will be created.

The University understands that it is not authorized to bind TNP to any third party for expenses incurred by the University or to bind TNP to any obligation or liability. In the event, a third party asserts a claim against TNP for obligations created by, or actions taken by, the University will, upon request, reimburse TNP for any such obligation or liability. The parties intend that the provisions of this program are for their benefit only and are not for the benefit of any third party, and accordingly, no third party shall have the right to enforce the provisions of this program.
